With the London 2012 Olympics and Paralympics fast approaching local businesses are being given the chance to find out more about how they can get involved.

Taking place on Tuesday, July 27 from 7.30am to approximately 9.00am the Kesgrave Conference Centre are hosting a business breakfast event providing helpful information about how local businesses can successfully bid for Olympic contracts.

The cost to business representatives wanting to attend the event is £10 and includes a breakfast.
